## **Wemyss Bay Community Association - New Members Needed**

### **Inverkip and Wemyss Bay Community Council**

Inverkip and Wemyss Bay Community Council, as part of its monthly Business Meeting on the 5th of January, hosted a discussion about the proposed housing development at the Inverkip Power Station site.

The application by Scottish Power Generating Ltd was due to be considered by Inverclyde Council's Planning Board at its November meeting but was withdrawn for technical reasons. It could be re-submitted at any time.

As concerns had been expressed to the Community Council, information sheets were delivered to most homes in Inverkip and Wemyss Bay in advance of the meeting, outlining those concerns. Despite the fact the Inverclyde Local Plan 2005 indicated 400 homes may be built on the site, following reconsideration by Inverclyde Council the numbers have risen to between 640 and 780 in an Urban Village.

Concerns and objections about the proposed development were expressed by all but one of the 130 people who attended the meeting. They included the high number of houses; additional vehicles joining an already overcrowded A78; no indications of improvements to the infrastructure of the area or extended school or medical facilities.
